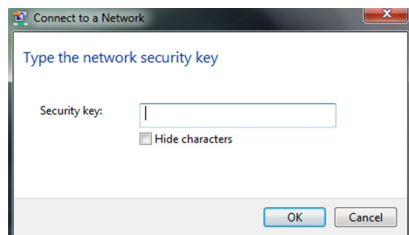




## HOW TO LOGIN AS A GUEST:

1. Turn on and log into your computer.
2. Make sure that wireless is turned on, then browse available wireless networks.
3. Connect to "BPL\_Guest".
4. You will be prompted to enter a security key. Please ask the library staff for this information since it changes weekly.
5. If prompted, select *Public* as the network location, click *Ok* then click *Close*.
6. You will be redirected to the library's website.
7. You are now free to search the web.



The "BPL\_Guest" wireless network is for library guests and active library cardholders in good standing who are waiting on their registered Wi-Fi accounts to be created and authorized (or reauthorized). We encourage all active cardholders in good standing to setup their own Wi-Fi account as explained at <http://www.bossierlibrary.org/wi-fi/>.

Anyone with a library account in bad standing will not intentionally be provided with the Wi-Fi security key and/or granted a registered Wi-Fi user account. Failure to comply in this matter could result in said user being blocked or banned from further Wi-Fi usage—please refer to our *Wireless Network Access Policy*.
