


LEARN ABOUT LIBBY!




The building icon (yes, it is actually a library!) takes you to the homepage of the Libby app. This is also where you can browse through suggested titles, newly added, and more!



The clock icon is your "timeline" which can show you titles you've borrowed, placed on hold, and returned.





At the end of February of this year, OverDrive removed the OverDrive app from stores. This was the first step towards phasing out their original app in favor of their new app: Libby.

Don't Panic! For those of you who have the OverDrive app downloaded, you can continue using it as it will remain active. However, we would recommend getting familiar with Libby if you aren't already because we know that the OverDrive app will be decommissioned in the near future. No date for that eventuality has been released at this time.


