All students enrolled in Bossier Parish Public Schools now have immediate access to digital resources* from Bossier Parish Libraries!

To determine your new Student eCard number, follow the steps below.

*Some resources require you to enter a PIN number. Your PIN number is the last four digits of your library card.

STEP 1

Your 14-digit library card number begins with 318. We've already filled in those boxes.

STEP 2

Know your Student ID Number? Great! These are the final numbers of your library card. Enter it into the boxes at the end. (The last number of your Student ID should be in the last box.)

STEP 3

Fill in any empty boxes with 0. That means any boxes between 318 and your Student ID number should be filled with a 0!
